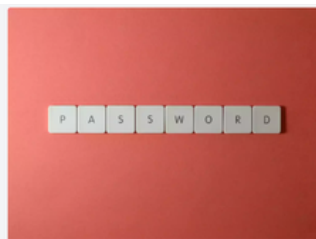
Later this month we will be undertaking further training: continuous professional development (CPD) is something that we are very committed to. Find out if, and how, this will effect you.

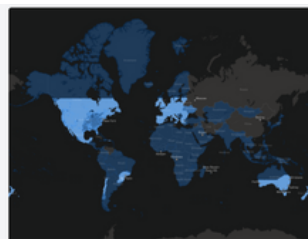

It's been claimed that over 80% of hacking-related breaches are due to weak or stolen passwords, so it seems that it would be very easy to dramatically improve security in this area.

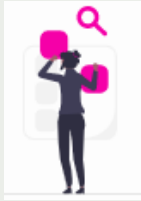


1ST JULY 2022

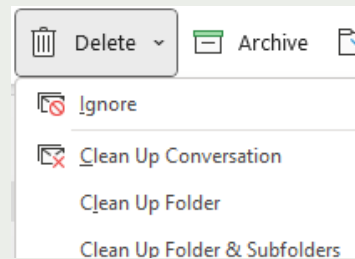
