To do this: Ctrl + Alt + Delete, click the Power icon (bottom right corner), select Restart from the list

Microsoft Office - hyperlinks



If you would like to insert a hyperlink into a document but don't want a long unsightly code, you can rename it to something more suitable, as follows:

• highlight link, right click, link, type new name in text to display, ok

If you would like to turn text (or an object) within a document, into a clickable hyperlink:

• highlight text/object, right click, link, select Link to as appropriate, copy and paste hyperlink into the Address box at the bottom (or use Look in to browse through files, etc.), ok
