Tips & Tricks

Outlook - Quick Parts

Save frequently used content (e.g., text, logos, tables, signatures) and easily insert them into your email whenever needed. To set up:

- In a new email document, create the content you wish to save
- Highlight content, click "Insert" (top left of page)
- Click on "Quick Parts" (in the "Text" group - top right)
- Select "Save Selection to Quick Part Gallery"
- Name your Quick Part and select other options to suit, OK

To use:

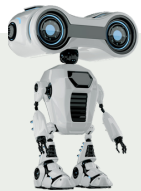
- In your email, place cursor where you wish to insert content
- Click "Insert" tab, click "Quick Parts" in the "Text" group
- Select desired Quick Part

In Praise of AI ..

There is a lot of fear around AI but there is also a lot to get excited about. The explosion in ai web/app tools is enabling people to do their job better, faster and with less effort. Each month we will review a collection and bring you those that seem most useful:

Chat GPT Plus

Unless you have been living on a desert island with no broadband, you will be familiar with Chat GPT - now there is a new subscription service available (\$20 p/m) called Chat GPT Plus which offers a number of benefits such as faster response and access even in peak use times, but the biggest advantage, I believe, is that it provides current information (Chat GPT's data only goes up to Sept 2021).
