Microsoft Office - Dictation

Dictation lets you use speech-to-text to author content in Office with a microphone and reliable internet connection. You can use your voice to quickly create word documents, emails, notes, presentations, or even slide notes:

- Simply open a new document
- Click on the microphone (labelled dictate voice) in the top ribbon
- Start dictating and watch your words appear on the screen

To ensure accuracy, speak slowly and clearly, and try to eliminate background noise.
