Tips & Tricks - Excel

Conditional Formatting

A useful tool for quickly identifying trends, patterns, and outliers in data. Use the Top/Bottom rule to highlight:

- the highest/lowest values in a range. By default, it highlights the top/bottom 10 items, but you can adjust this number to any desired value
- the highest values that fall within the top/bottom % of the data set. The % can be customized
- all values in the range that are above/below the average value of the data set

Here's how:

- Highlight data range
- Select Home tab, Conditional Formatting, Top/Bottom Rules
- Select rule, adjust to suit, OK
