Tips & Tricks

Outlook - Advanced Find

This is a powerful tool for searching emails, contacts, calendar items, tasks, and other Outlook objects. Simply press:

Ctrl + Shift + F

To:

- Search in specific folders or across Outlook
- Search by Date Ranges
- Search for items with attachments
- Use Logical Operators such as AND, OR, and NOT
- Add or remove fields to customize your search criteria
- Use Multiple Criteria eg. sender, keywords in the subject or body, attachments, dates, etc.
- Save your searches for future use

QR Code Scam

One of our priorities, here at Interfuture, is cyber security and through 24/7 monitoring and protection we are able to filter out most of the malicious spam emails that you would otherwise be bombarded with each day. If you do receive an email that you think looks suspicious, please send it to us at: suspicious@interfuture.co.uk and we will take it from there. A new emerging scam to watch for is:

Quishing - a form of scam where the recipient is asked to scan a QR code included in the email. Users are more likely to use their personal phone to scan the QR code and personal devices may not have the same security protections as a computer that's provided by an employer.
