## Tips & Tricks - Microsoft Office

#### Collaboration / Co-Authoring

Allows multiple users to work together on the same document, at the same time. Here's how:

- open the (Word, Excel, Power Point, OneNote) document you wish to share
- click on "Share" (top right corner)
- select a method to share the document eg. inviting people via email
- set the desired permissions for the collaborators (viewing, editing, etc.)

Once you've shared the document, you and your collaborators can work on it simultaneously. You can see each other's changes in real-time, and the document will be automatically saved as you go.
